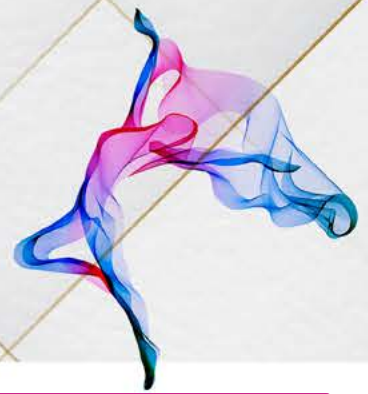

- Once you sign up, you can also continue working on abstract until you finally decide to submit before the deadline.
- This is an automated system that will allow you to put the information online for the authors, affiliations, abstract text (if required with special characters etc.) and keywords in a series of different window.
- You can track the whole submission and evaluation procedure either within the system or by e-mail notification.
- In case of submitting more than one abstract you can use the same login and password for each abstract via online submission module.

Instructions for Online Poster Presentations.

- All Abstracts should be submitted in English only. Abstracts submitted by e-mail, fax or post will NOT be accepted.
- The abstracts have to be structured as follows: (Aim, Material Method, Results, Discussion, Conclusion).
- The abstracts for poster presentation should be submitted until March 20, 2022. This date will NOT be postponed.
- All submitted abstracts will be reviewed by the Scientific Committee. The abstracts scheduled for poster presentations will be announced on March 27, 2022. It will be displayed as e-posters. All accepted abstracts presenters must be register to the Meeting.

The scientific committee would like to request from the presenters to prepare their main themes as E-POSTER for the Meeting. E-Poster Submission Deadline is March 31, 2022.

Official Language of Virtual Meeting: Official language of the meeting and of correspondence is English. There will be a simultaneous translation (English-Turkish-Russian) in the main meeting hall.

Virtual Meeting Registration: Registration is free of charge. You need to register via vaisummit2022.serenaslive.com in order to view online sessions and submit questions.

Certificate of Virtual Attendance: The participants' attendance to the sessions will be monitored by Serenas Live. The participants who attend at least 75% of the sessions can request their certificate of participation from the kiosk at the Atrium after filling in the evaluation form.

Viewing the Sessions: You can click and enter the Meeting Room according to the schedule, view the sessions and ask questions to the speakers.

Depending on which internet browser you are using the sessions may start muted.

In this case, you can turn the sound on by clicking the speaker icon on the top of the video player.

The sessions will be streamed live over the internet, the viewing quality may vary depending on your internet service provider's infrastructure and your connection speed. You can change the live stream quality by clicking the cogwheel icon on the bottom right of the video player, so that you can choose the quality of your viewing and the data usage depending on quality.

While viewing on your mobile devices, the streaming quality will be determined automatically depending on the brand and operating system of your device and the viewing options might vary between Apple and Android devices.

Regardless of whether you are using a computer, tablet or a mobile phone, you can click on the icon on the bottom right to view in full screen mode.

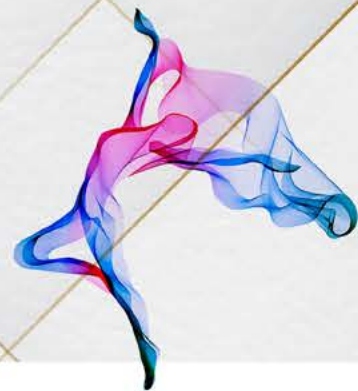

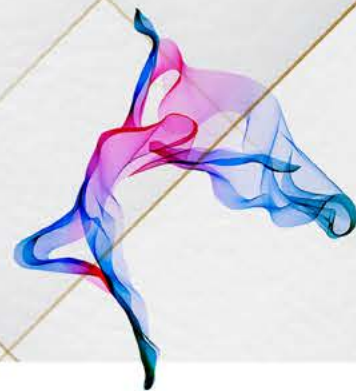
